



Nakasendo Post Towns, Ena Gorge & Inuyama Castle Day Tour

(NAKASENDO-INUYAMA-ENA)

- Visit Inuyama Castle, one of Japan’s oldest surviving wooden castle keeps and a designated National Treasure.
- Enjoy dramatic scenery at Ena Gorge, known for its cliffs, unique rock formations, and scenic viewpoints.
- Walk through the historic Nakasendo post towns of Magome-juku and Tsumago-juku, with well-preserved Edo-period streets and traditional architecture.

08: 30	Nagoya	Begin your day tour. In front of Nagoya Station (meet at the MINISTOP convenience store behind Nagoya West Exit BIC CAMERA)
09: 30	Inuyama	▼Inuyama Castle (about 60 minutes, admission ticket included) Inuyama Castle stands on a hill overlooking the Kiso River in Inuyama City, Aichi Prefecture. Built in the 16th century, its wooden keep is one of Japan’s twelve surviving original castle towers and is designated as a National Treasure. Together with Himeji Castle, Matsumoto Castle, and Hikone Castle, it is recognized as one of Japan’s four National Treasure castles.
12: 00	Ena	▼Ena Gorge Observation Deck (about 30 minutes) Enjoy panoramic views of Ena Gorge, a scenic valley in eastern Gifu shaped by the Kiso River and Oi Dam Lake. The gorge is known for its dramatic cliffs, unusual rock formations, and seasonal scenery, including cherry blossoms, azaleas, and autumn foliage. You can also view the distinctive Umbrella Rock, a designated Natural Monument of Japan.
13: 20	Magome-juku	▼Magome-juku (about 90 minutes, including free time for lunch) Magome-juku is a beautifully preserved Edo-period post town along the historic Nakasendo Trail, which once connected Kyoto and Edo (present-day Tokyo). Stroll along its traditional stone-paved streets, wooden buildings, local shops, and cafés while enjoying the atmosphere of old Japan. Free time is available for lunch and independent exploration.
15: 30	Tsumago-juku	▼Tsumago-juku (about 60 minutes) Tsumago-juku is a quiet, well-preserved post town along the historic Nakasendo Trail. Its traditional wooden buildings, peaceful streets, and Edo-period atmosphere offer a charming contrast to the livelier Magome-juku. The scenic trail connecting Tsumago-juku and Magome-juku is also popular with hikers.
16: 30	return	End the trip and start returning. The return time is for reference only. You may return earlier due to smooth itinerary and good road conditions on the day.
18: 20	Nagoya	Arrive at Nagoya Station and end the tour near the same meeting point.

1) Shared round-trip transportation by air-conditioned vehicle, with driver service as specified in the itinerary; 2) Admission tickets to Inuyama Castle; 3) Vehicle fuel costs, tolls, and highway tolls;Vehicle service time: within 10 hours (Japanese law); 4) Driver service fee (exquisite small group of 1-13 people; bus group of 14-45 people, actual will be adjusted according to the number of people in the group on that day); 5) Reference models: 5-7-seater cars: Toyota Alphard or similar; 9-14-seater cars: Toyota HAICE or similar; 18-22-seater cars: small buses; 22-seater cars and above: large buses. 8) This is a shared group tour. The vehicle is not exclusive to your party.If you require a flexible itinerary, please refer to our private charter tour service.

9) No refund will be provided if a guest fails to join or withdraws from the tour due to personal reasons or late arrival.
- If a guest leaves the group during the tour without authorization, the tour will be deemed cancelled and no refund will be provided. The guest shall also be responsible for any resulting personal injury or property loss.

- GUEST ELIGIBILITY
- 1) Guests aged 70 or above must be in suitable health for travel and must be accompanied throughout the tour by a family member or friend aged 22 or above.

2) Guests under 18 years old must be accompanied throughout the tour by at least one adult passenger.

3) Elderly guests are required to provide a health certificate. Please complete the certificate and submit it to the booking staff before departure. An electronic copy is acceptable.

4) Pregnant guests and guests with heart disease, acrophobia, or other special conditions are not recommended to join this tour and may be refused participation. Please book with caution.

5) Guests who are not Chinese mainland nationals may book this product. However, language services are available only in Chinese and Japanese.

- ITINERARY NOTES
- 1) Arrival times may vary due to unpredictable traffic conditions, weather, holidays, and crowds. Under Japanese law, the driver’s maximum working time is 10 hours. To ensure driver safety and stable operation, the itinerary may be adjusted according to actual conditions, including reducing sightseeing time or cancelling certain attractions. We sincerely ask for your understanding and support for adjustments made to ensure safety.

- TRAVEL INFORMATION
- 1) Pickup and Meeting Point
Please arrive at the designated pickup point at the specified time. Late arrival is not permitted. This product cannot be cancelled, changed, transferred to another departure, or joined midway. Guests who miss the tour for personal reasons shall bear the resulting loss.

2) During the Tour

- Guests may not leave the group early or leave the tour midway. Any unused portion will be considered voluntarily forfeited and will not be refunded. Guests shall be responsible for any accident occurring after leaving the group.

- During peak travel seasons or other special periods, the departure time may be brought forward or slightly delayed. The final departure time is subject to the guide’s notification.

- Transportation, sightseeing, and stopover times are subject to actual conditions on the day. In special circumstances, such as traffic congestion or adverse weather, the guide may reasonably adjust the order of attractions after consulting with guests, provided that no attraction is removed from the itinerary.
