D1 / 10:30	Yamanashi	▼ Mt. Fuji 5th Station (approximately 40 minutes) (This itinerary visits Mt. Fuji 5th Station instead of Arakurayama Sengen Park from April 26 to November 30 each year.) Enjoy a closer view of Mt. Fuji at the 5th Station. Mt. Fuji 5th Station is located halfway up the mountain at an elevation of approximately 2,305 meters. Japan's highest mountain offers a completely different atmosphere when viewed up close. From this point, you can look up at the summit and appreciate the impressive scale of Mt. Fuji. On clear days, you can enjoy wide views of the surrounding scenery, including Lake Kawaguchi. When the mountain is covered in clouds and mist, you may also see a beautiful sea of clouds. ▼ Arakurayama Sengen Park, a popular photo spot for panoramic views of Mt. Fuji (approximately 1 hour) (This itinerary visits Arakurayama Sengen Park instead of Mt. Fuji 5th Station from December 1 to April 25 of the following year.) This recently popularized attraction is regarded as one of the "21 places photographers should visit before they die." It is one of the best locations for panoramic views of Mt. Fuji. After climbing the 397 steps near the main shrine, you will see the five-story Chureito Pagoda. From here, you can capture the pagoda, Mt. Fuji, and the city below in one iconic view. The park is beautiful throughout the year, with cherry blossoms in spring, fresh greenery in summer, autumn foliage, and snow-covered scenery in winter. In addition to the spectacular view of Mt. Fuji, you can also look out over the charming streets of Fujiyoshida. ▼ Walk around Lake Kawaguchi and enjoy views of Mt. Fuji (approximately 90 minutes) Lake Kawaguchi is located at an elevation of approximately 830 meters and covers an area of 5.7 square kilometers. Its winding shoreline offers many excellent viewpoints of Mt. Fuji. You can also capture beautiful reflections of Mt. Fuji on the surface of the lake. Recommended activity: Kachi Kachi Mountain Ropeway Ride the Kachi Kachi Mountain Ropeway beside Lake Kawaguchi and enjoy scenic views along the way. From the observation deck at approximately 1,075 meters, you can enjoy panoramic views of Mt. Fuji and Lake Kawaguchi. On clear days, the Southern Alps may also be visible. At the summit, you can ring the "Tenjo no Kane" Bell, which is said to make wishes come true. The ropeway ticket is not included. Reference price: JPY 1,000 per person for a round trip, payable at your own expense. If the ropeway is suspended due to strong winds, lightning, or other safety-related conditions, or if overcrowding prevents boarding as scheduled, the itinerary will be changed to sightseeing around Lake Kawaguchi. The outlet features a wide selection of popular Japanese and international brands, including luxury labels such as Gucci and Prada, often at attractive outlet prices. It is an excellent stop for guests who enjoy shopping.
D1 / 18:40	Izu	▼ Stay one night at a hot spring hotel near Shuzenji, known as the "Little Kyoto of Izu," with a Japanese-style dinner and breakfast included. Special arrangements have been made for an overnight stay at a open-air hot spring hotel. Enjoy wearing a traditional Japanese yukata, savoring Japanese cuisine including sashimi appetizers and a Wagyu hot pot set meal, and relaxing in a natural hot spring known for its skin-beautifying qualities. Enjoy another hot spring bath in the morning and begin today's itinerary after breakfast. ▼ Shuzenji, known as the "Little Kyoto of Izu" (approximately 90 minutes) Located in the center of the Izu Peninsula, Shuzenji is a popular destination awarded two stars by the Michelin Green Guide Japan. It is home to one of the oldest hot springs in the Izu Peninsula and is closely associated with Yasunari Kawabata's novel The Izu Dancer. The area has long been loved by scholars, artists, and writers, earning it the name "Little Kyoto of Izu." It was also featured as a getaway destination in the popular Japanese drama a popular Japanese TV drama. With its scenic beauty, historic sites, and traditional hot springs, Shuzenji offers an authentic Japanese atmosphere. Lover's Bridges Five red bridges cross the Katsura River in the town: Katsura Bridge, Torokko Bridge, Kaede Bridge, Togetsu Bridge, and Taki-shita Bridge. Each bridge is associated with a different wish, and local legend says that wishes may come true when visitors cross them while making a wish. Shuzenji Temple Shuzenji Temple has a history of approximately 1,200 years and is believed to have been founded by the Buddhist monk Kobo Daishi in 807, during the early Heian period. According to legend, Kobo Daishi saw a child washing an ill parent with cold water. Moved by the scene, he struck the Katsura River with his staff, causing a hot spring to emerge. The child used the hot spring water to help cure the parent's illness, and the area became famous for its healing waters. Bamboo Forest Path Walk along the bamboo forest path and stand on the bridge overlooking the Katsura River. The winding river, flowing stream, and clear birdsong among the bamboo create a peaceful and atmospheric experience. 1,200-Year-Old Kawayay Free Foot Bath Kawayay, also known as Tokko-no-Yu, is a public foot bath with a history of approximately 1,200 years. Relax your feet in the warm spring water while listening to the flowing river and enjoying the gentle steam and tranquil scenery.

D2 / 11:30	Izu	▼ Jogasaki Coast (approximately 1 hour) + 1 hour of free time for lunch The rugged beauty of Izu's eastern coast is sure to exceed your expectations. Jogasaki Coast was formed by lava that flowed into the sea from volcanic eruptions of Mt. Omuro and Mt. Amagi approximately 4,000 years ago. The lava was gradually shaped by seawater erosion. The coastline features a lush natural forest plateau, rugged coastal rocks, crashing waves, and dramatic cliffs rising several dozen meters above the sea. Stretching approximately 9 kilometers from Futo in the north to Yawatano in the south, the coast offers spectacular ocean views and distant views of Oshima and other Izu Islands. A natural walking trail follows the coastline, including the rugged Kadonowaki Suspension Bridge. ▼ Atami Herb Rose Garden and Coeda House seaside dessert café designed by Kengo Kuma (approximately 90 minutes) Visit the Akao Herb & Rose Garden, an award-winning garden and one of the closest gardens to the sea on the Izu Peninsula. Known as the "Sea of Flowers in Atami," the garden offers beautiful seasonal flowers and panoramic ocean views. Located at one of the garden's best viewpoints, Coeda House is a unique architectural work designed by renowned Japanese architect Kengo Kuma. The building is constructed mainly from natural wood and features floor-to-ceiling windows and extensive glass elements, offering an unobstructed 360-degree view of the surrounding garden and sea. From a distance, the café appears to float above the garden like a rooftop, creating a dreamlike atmosphere. In addition to its distinctive architecture, Coeda House is also known for its desserts. Pastry chef Koji Fujii, who won third place in an international pastry competition, creates limited-edition desserts using seasonal and locally sourced ingredients. ※ Admission fee: JPY 3,000 per person, payable at your own expense.

- 1) Shared round-trip transportation by air-conditioned vehicle, with driver service as specified in the itinerary;
- 2) One-night stay at a hot spring hotel, including breakfast and dinner. A single-room supplement of JPY 12000 per person applies. Children under 6 years old who do not occupy a bed receive a JPY 8000 discount per person. The final room supplement and child discount will be confirmed at the time of booking.
- 3) Vehicle fuel costs, tolls, and highway tolls. Vehicle service time: within 10 hours (Japanese law);
- 4) Driver service fee (exquisite small group of 1-13 people; bus group of 14-45 people, actual will be adjusted according to the number of people in the group on that day);
- 5) Reference models: 5-7-seater cars: Toyota Alphard or similar; 9-14-seater cars: Toyota HAICE or similar; 18-22-seater cars: small buses; 22-seater cars and above: large buses. 1) Pickup and Meeting Point
