10: 40	Nikko	▼Toshogu Shrine (Stay about 120 minutes, free time, lunch at your own expense) Nikko Toshogu Shrine is located in the mountains of Nikko City, Tochigi. It is the main shrine of Toshogu Shrine. The main enshrined deity is Tosho Ogongen (Tokugawa Ieyasu). Toshogu Shrine enshrines Tokugawa Ieyasu, the first shogun of the Edo shogunate. It has rich historical sites. The architecture of Toshogu Shrine is exquisitely carved and magnificent. It is located among the Nikko Mountains and is built against the mountains. It is full of momentum. Among them, the Japanese-style Mingyang Gate and the Chinese-style Tang Gate are its representative buildings. Its design aesthetic also interprets different metaphors, "Sleeping Cat": the carved sleeping cat has two flying sparrows on its back. This symbiotic coexistence between animals is said to symbolize the peaceful future of the newly unified Japan, and it is also the most famous sculpture of Toshogu Shrine - "Sanbu monkey". The first one is "not seen", the second one is "not spoken", and the third one is "not heard". Every corner of Toshogu Shrine has its own story, which is very interesting. In December 1999, the "Shrines and Temples of Nikko" including Nikko Toshogu Shrine were designated as a World Cultural Heritage. ※Admission fee is not included and must be paid at your own expense. Adults and high school students: JPY 1,600; elementary and junior high school students: JPY 550.
14: 00	Nikko	▼Irohazaka Winding Road (drive through without stopping) Irohazaka Winding Road is one of the "Top 100 Roads in Japan". It is 15.8 kilometers long from Nikko City to Lake Chuzenji and Oku-Nikko. There are a total of 48 turns in the up/down route. It is a mountain road in the Nikko area and is famous for its beautiful driving routes. In autumn, the mountain trails are the most beautiful and very popular. Due to the different heights of the mountains, you can enjoy the entire red leaves of various colors, which makes you feel relaxed and breathtaking. You can also view Kegon Falls and Lake Chuzenji from the Akechidaira Ropeway. ▼ Akechidaira Ropeway & Observation Deck (about 60 minutes, admission ticket included) Akechidaira Observation Deck is the most popular observation deck in the Nikko area, where you can enjoy Lake Chuzenji and Kegon Falls at the same time. From the east side of the observatory, you can also see Pingfeng Rock, which is composed of continuous cliffs, and the rolling mountains in the distance. It only takes 3 minutes to take the cable car from Akechidaira to the observation deck located at an altitude of 1,373 meters.
15: 20	Nikko	▼Lake Chuzenji (about 60 minutes) Lake Chuzenji is the highest natural lake in Japan. In Lake Chuzenji, there are azaleas in spring, green trees in summer, red leaves in autumn, and snowy scenery in winter. There are beautiful scenery for tourists to enjoy in all four seasons. It is particularly famous for the azaleas in spring and the red leaves in autumn. During this period, there is an endless stream of people visiting with cameras in order to take their favorite photos. ▼Kegon Falls (Free time: 30 minutes) Kegon Falls - one of the three famous waterfalls in Japan and a famous tourist destination. The water from Chuzenji Lake forms the Ojiri River at the eastern end, crosses Mount Nantai, and flows down from a height of 700 meters to form the main part of the waterfall, which is 99 meters high. The upper rock protrudes forward, and 12 small waterfalls flow out of the rock gaps. In autumn, the surrounding red leaves are covered with beautiful scenery. It is the tourist center of Nikko National Park. It is very suitable for taking pictures and has the artistic conception of mountains and flowing water. If you choose to use the elevator, the fee is at your own expense.
17: 00		Depart for return to Tokyo city. The return time is for reference only. You may return earlier due to smooth itinerary, good road conditions, etc. on the day.
19: 00	Tokyo	Estimated arrival at JR Tokyo Station Marunouchi North Exit, Shinjuku West Exit (in front of Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation), or your hotel/B&B. Tour ends upon arrival. VIPs who have a boarding and alighting package can break up the group directly at Tokyo Station or Shinjuku to end their trip. VIP guests of the hotel and B&B pick-up package should wait for the shuttle bus to arrive and arrange to return to the hotel/B&B to end the trip.

INCLUDED

- 1) Shared round-trip transportation by air-conditioned vehicle, with driver service as specified in the itinerary;
- 2) Admission ticket for Akechidaira Ropeway & Observation Deck;
- 3) Vehicle fuel costs, tolls, and highway tolls; Vehicle service time: within 10 hours (Japanese law);
- 4) Driver service fee (exquisite small group of 1-13 people; bus group of 14-45 people, actual will be adjusted according to the number of people in the group on that day);
- 5) Reference models: 5-7-seater cars: Toyota Alphard or similar; 9-14-seater cars: Toyota HAICE or similar; 18-22-seater cars: small buses; 22-seater cars and above: large buses. The above vehicles are for reference only, and the actual number will be adjusted according to the number of people traveling on the day;
- 6) Children aged 0-2 are free of charge without occupying a seat; children aged 3 and above are treated as adults.

- 1) Accommodation expenses, meals, other attraction tickets, local self-funded projects and other personal consumption expenses;

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1) Luggage is accepted subject to vehicle capacity. Please provide the number and approximate size of your luggage when booking. Additional or oversized luggage may incur an extra charge or may not be accepted.
- 2) Once a booking has been confirmed, the travel date cannot be changed arbitrarily. Any resulting loss shall be borne by the guest.
- 3) Please provide complete booking information, including your name, number of participants, phone number, WeChat ID or WhatsApp number, and boarding location, to avoid errors that may affect the itinerary.
- 4) Please carry and carefully safeguard your passport and valuables throughout the tour. Guests shall be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage.
- 5) Elderly guests, guests with hypertension, heart disease, or other cardiovascular conditions, and pregnant guests are advised to travel with a family member or companion.
- 6) Guests under 18 years old may not book this tour independently. A legal guardian must book and accompany them.
- 7) This is a fixed shared-vehicle itinerary. Guests must follow the scheduled stay duration at each attraction and the instructions of the driver and guide.
- 8) This is a shared group tour. The vehicle is not exclusive to your party. If you require a flexible itinerary, please refer to our private charter tour service.
- 9) No refund will be provided if a guest fails to join or withdraws from the tour due to personal reasons or late arrival.

If a guest leaves the group during the tour without authorization, the tour will be deemed cancelled and no refund will be provided. The guest shall also be responsible for any resulting personal injury or property loss.

- 10) Arrival times may vary due to traffic conditions, weather, holidays, crowds, or other force majeure events. In the event of delays or cancellation caused by such circumstances, no refund may be requested on this basis.

GUEST ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Guests aged 70 or above must be in suitable health for travel and must be accompanied throughout the tour by a family member or friend aged 22 or above.
- 2) Guests under 18 years old must be accompanied throughout the tour by at least one adult passenger.
- 3) Elderly guests are required to provide a health certificate. Please complete the certificate and submit it to the booking staff before departure. An electronic copy is acceptable.
- 4) Pregnant guests and guests with heart disease, acrophobia, or other special conditions are not recommended to join this tour and may be refused participation. Please book with caution.
- 5) Guests who are not Chinese mainland nationals may book this product. However, language services are available only in Chinese and Japanese.

ITINERARY NOTES

- 1) Arrival times may vary due to unpredictable traffic conditions, weather, holidays, and crowds. Under Japanese law, the driver's maximum working time is 10 hours. To ensure driver safety and stable operation, the itinerary may be adjusted according to actual conditions, including reducing sightseeing time or cancelling certain attractions. We sincerely ask for your understanding and support for adjustments made to ensure safety.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

1) Pickup and Meeting Point

Please arrive at the designated pickup point at the specified time. Late arrival is not permitted. This product cannot be cancelled, changed, transferred to another departure, or joined midway. Guests who miss the tour for personal reasons shall bear the resulting loss.

2) During the Tour

- Guests may not leave the group early or leave the tour midway. Any unused portion will be considered voluntarily forfeited and will not be refunded. Guests shall be responsible for any accident occurring after leaving the group.
 - During peak travel seasons or other special periods, the departure time may be brought forward or slightly delayed. The final departure time is subject to the guide's notification.
 - Transportation, sightseeing, and stopover times are subject to actual conditions on the day. In special circumstances, such as traffic congestion or adverse weather, the guide may reasonably adjust the order of attractions after consulting with guests, provided that no attraction is removed from the itinerary.
 - Meals are not included. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are at your own expense. Some restaurants do not allow outside food or guests to occupy a seat without ordering. Please take note.
 - 3) Local Customs and Regulations

- 4) Weather
