- Visit Amanohashidate, one of Japan's "Three Scenic Views," with panoramic views of the famous pine-covered sandbar
- Explore Ine Funaya, a unique seaside village known for its traditional boat houses and peaceful coastal scenery
- Enjoy free time in Osaka's Shinsaibashi and Dotonbori shopping and dining districts

We will not wait for late arrivals, so it is recommended to wait at the meeting location 10 minutes before departure. 11: 20	Kyoto	▼ One of the "Three Scenic Spots of Japan" ~ Amanohashidate Viewing Spot (about 2.5 hours, including lunch time at your own expense, please pay for yourself) "Amanohashidate" on Miyazu Bay in the Sea of Japan is one of the "Three Scenic Spots of Japan" together with "Matsushima" in Mutsu and "Miyajima" in Aki. It is about 3.6 kilometers long. It is a sandbar formed by the sand spit along the coast. There are about 8,000 pine trees of various sizes on it. There are white beaches on the east and west sides. It is a special natural landscape. Its shape is like a bridge extending diagonally toward the sky, hence the name "Amanohashidate". Because it is located at the intersection of the Aso Sea and the Japan Sea Miyazu Bay, you can not only enjoy the pure natural scenery, but also have a sweeping view of the vast sea view of the island. Located on Mt. Monju, Amanohashidate View Land offers a panoramic view of the sandbar. The mountaintop has an observation area, a Ferris wheel and family-friendly attractions. From here, Amanohashidate resembles a dragon soaring into the sky, a view known as the "Flying Dragon View." Amanohashidate View Land Ropeway/Monorail Round-Trip Ticket The ticket is valid for a round trip by either the chairlift or monorail. Admission is at your own expense. Reference price: JPY 1,000 per adult. Jieunji Temple and Monju-do at Chionji Temple (a temple for praying for academic achievements) Zhien Temple is dedicated to Kirito Manjusri, the Bodhisattva who controls wisdom, and prays for success in studies, similar to Emperor Cangwenchang. The gate of Chionji Temple is the largest in the Tango area. What's special here is the signed poem in the shape of a fan. If the fan is hung upside down, the surface of the fan will change from thin to wide, which means it will gradually become more beautiful. The adjacent swing bridge, the bridge connecting Amanohashidate and Monjudo land, when a large ship wants to pass, the swing bridge will rotate 90 degrees to allow the ship to pass (from time to time). (Tickets are free) Take a stroll or play at the beach There are white beaches on both sides of the Amanohashidate Sandbank. The sand is fine and soft. It is also a pleasure to walk in the pine forest of Amanohashidate and admire the different types and shapes of pine trees. There is Amanohashidate Shrine in the middle of Amanohashidate, which is a good place to pray for success in love. There is also an ancient well here, and its "Isoshimizu" is one of the top 100 famous waters in Japan. Remember to wash your hands before praying. It opens as a bathing beach in the summer. There are no admission fees. There are changing rooms, lifeguards and coin-operated showers. The pine trees on the beach are densely covered with paper strips, forming natural parasols. Amanohashidate Hot Spring - Chie no Yu There is Amanohashidate Hot Spring in front of JR Amanohashidate Station. It is said that the natural spring water here has the effect of beautifying skin and skin care. If you are interested, you can take a dip in it (the external foot bath is free, please pay for the admission fee of 700 yen)
14: 30	Kyoto	▼ Ine Funaya-"Venice City of Japan" and "The Last Secret of Kyoto" (about 1 hour, walk or ride or take a boat to feed the seagulls, please pay the excluded fee for the boat trip) [Ine Village] was rated by the Japanese as one of the 18 most beautiful villages in Japan. It has Japan's unique floating boat house building, which allows you to experience the original ecological scenery that is not found in tourist resorts. There are about 230 boat houses along the coast of Ine Bay facing south for 5 kilometers. Today, people still coexist with the sea in front of them. The transparent and beautiful sea, the dark green mountains, the rapidly changing sky colors, and the colors of the funaya buildings that represent Japanese style. These are pure natural colors that can only be experienced in Ine Town. The fishing villages located along the coast are far away from the hustle and bustle and full of simple innocence. boat tour You can experience the cruise at your own expense, spending about 25 minutes traveling around Ine Bay, and you can also feed seagulls. Enjoy the view of the funa house from the deck on the second floor, and feel the special time with your family The boat departs every hour and half-hour. Boat tickets are not included and must be paid at your own expense: JPY 1,200 for adults and JPY 600 for children. If services are suspended due to strong winds or rough seas, the activity will be replaced with free time to explore on foot. cycling tour Egan provides free bicycles, allowing guests to freely explore the village. You can ride or return them directly to any rental point. It feels wonderful to ride a bicycle in a deserted alley. (Free, there are 5 parking spots in the village, you can park at any time, super convenient)
15: 30	return	We happily ended the day's tour and started to return.
18: 00	Kyoto	Kyoto disbands at 18:00. The return time is for reference only. You may return earlier due to smooth itinerary, good road conditions, etc. on the day.
19: 00	Osaka	▼SHINSAIBASHI & DOTONBORI (FREE TIME / TOUR ENDS) Guests using the meeting-point pickup and drop-off option may get off in the Shinsaibashi area and end the tour there. This will be considered a voluntary waiver of the hotel drop-off service, and no refund will be provided for the transportation fee. Guests who do not wish to visit Shinsaibashi and require hotel/B&B drop-off should wait for the shuttle bus and return directly to their hotel or B&B. SHINSAIBASHI Explore Osaka 's famous shopping district, home to department stores, drugstores, long-established brands, and specialty shops. Enjoy a wide range of cosmetics, fashion, souvenirs, and character goods, with many stores offering Chinese-language assistance and UnionPay payment. DOTONBORI Discover Osaka 's lively food district, famous for its "kuidaore" food culture. Try takoyaki, okonomiyaki, ramen, local izakayas, and popular restaurants such as Kani Doraku.

- 1) Pickup and Meeting Point

- 2) During the Tour
 - Guests may not leave the group early or leave the tour midway. Any unused portion will be considered voluntarily forfeited and will not be refunded. Guests shall be responsible for any accident occurring after leaving the group.
 - During peak travel seasons or other special periods, the departure time may be brought forward or slightly delayed. The final departure time is subject to the guide's notification.
