10:00	Kamakura	▼Kamakura Daibutsu (Free time: 30 minutes) The Great Buddha of Kamakura is a bronze seated statue of Amida Tathagata located in the Kotoku-in Temple of the Pure Land Buddhism in the ancient capital of Kamakura. It is commonly known as the Great Buddha of Kamakura. It is the symbol of the ancient capital of Kamakura. The Great Buddha has a net height of 11.3 meters, a height of 13.35 meters including the pedestal, and a weight of approximately 121 tons. The Buddha statue was built in 1252. The Buddha’s flatter face, lower bun and forward leaning posture have the style of the Song Dynasty Buddha statues popular in the Kamakura period. It is a representative statue of the Kamakura period and is designated as a national treasure of Japan. Unlike the Great Buddha of Nara Todaiji Temple, which has undergone many repairs in later generations, the Great Buddha of Kamakura has basically maintained its original form, so it is very precious. Minamoto Yoritomo established the first samurai regime in Kamakura, the Kamakura Shogunate (1192-1333). Therefore, during these 140 years, Kamakura, as the center of Japan at that time, experienced tremendous development in politics, economy, culture and other aspects. However, as the central position of the Muromachi shogunate was established, Kamakura began to decline due to being squeezed out. Especially after the Battle of Sogoku Furukawa in the first year of Kangsheng (1455), Kamakura even retreated into a village with only agriculture and fishing. Until the middle of the Edo period, with the revival of shrines and temples, Kamakura gradually evolved into an important tourist area in Japan. ※ Please pay your own admission: JPY 300 per person; entering the interior of the Great Buddha requires an additional JPY 50.
10:40	Kamakura	▼Enoden experience (time required: about 10 to 15 minutes) is included in the experience fee Enoden is a streetcar that connects Fujisawa to Kamakura. The route covers most of Kamakura’s famous attractions, and you can also enjoy the beautiful Shonan coast scenery. As long as we talk about Kamakura, the indispensable representative means of transportation is Enoden. The scene of a train speeding past often appears in major Japanese film and animation works. Therefore, you can not only watch from a distance, but also experience the fun of riding Enoden in person. ※Travel by Enoden from Hase Station to Kamakura-Kokomae Station and Enoshima Station. Please be sure to follow the tour guide closely on the way to take the tram. If you fall behind halfway, you will be responsible for the consequences. This fee is a complimentary item and will not be refunded if you are unable to ride Enoden due to force majeure. ▼Kamakura High School (40 minutes stay) Kamakura High School is located in Kamakura City, Kanagawa, Japan. It is the prototype of Lingnan High School in "Slam Dunk"; the intersection not far from the station is the location for the classic scene of Sakuragi Hanamichi greeting Akagi Haruko. Standing at the intersection, amid the jingling of bells, you can also feel the passionate youth memories of Slam Dunk. Now, many years later, everyone can’t help but take photos when they come here, as if they are commemorating their youthful years. I feel like what we are witnessing is not a memory. The sea, the campus, and the streets in the Slam Dunk scene are so important to everyone born in the 1980s, because they can go to the place in their youth memories to verify it, as if they can re-experience the breath of youth for a moment, and they can calmly have one more reason to say BYE BYE to it. Shonan Coast Walk Passing through the railway crossing and the road, and going down the stairs is the famous Shonan coast in Kanto, Japan. It is a paradise for surfers and those who enjoy seaside activities. Stroll on the beach, listen to the waves and relax. And if the weather is good, you can also see Mt. Fuji directly. In addition, it is often featured in Japanese travel programs, TV, movies and other works. ※If there are force majeure factors such as excessive wind and waves, we may not go to the coast depending on the situation.
12:00	Fujisawa	▼Enoshima (stay 120 minutes) Explore Enoshima Island at your own pace, with time to visit Enoshima Shrine, enjoy the sea views, and browse the island’s shops and cafés. Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine (90 minutes stay) Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine, formerly known as Kamakura Hachimangu Shrine, was the central belief and patron saint of samurai during the Kamakura shogunate period (1192). It has a deep connection with the first shogun of Kamakura and is quite famous in the Kanto area. Together with Ishikimizu Hachimangu Shrine (Kyoto) and Usa Hachimangu Shrine (Oita, Kyushu), they are collectively known as the three major Hachimangu Shrines in Japan. The shrine’s territory is vast, and many areas are designated as national historic sites. In addition, many flowers and plants are planted inside, and it is also a famous local place for cherry blossom and maple viewing. It was also awarded one star by the Michelin Guide. Komachi Street Komachi Street extending from Kamakura Station to Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine is a very famous and lively old street in Kamakura. There are many shops on both sides of the street selling all kinds of small things. Kamakura has a wide variety of souvenirs, Japanese handicrafts, and local delicacies, and is very popular among locals and tourists. Many of these restaurants are famous gourmet restaurants listed on major website platforms and guide books. If you pass by, don’t miss it.
16:00		Depart for Tokyo. The return time is for reference only. You may return earlier due to smooth itinerary, good road conditions, etc. on the day.
18:00	Tokyo	Estimated arrival at JR Tokyo Station Marunouchi North Exit, Shinjuku West Exit (in front of Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation), or your hotel/B&B. Tour ends upon arrival. Assemble and get off the bus. VIPs picked up from hotels and B&Bs can end the trip directly at Tokyo Station or Shinjuku. Shinjuku Station is one of the most important transportation hubs in Tokyo. With nearly 4 million passengers every day, it is the most visited railway station in the world. In addition, there are other well-known attractions such as Shinjuku Gyoen National Garden for cherry blossom viewing, Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building, and Golden Street.

- 5) Guests who are not Chinese mainland nationals may book this product. However, language services are available only in Chinese and Japanese.

1) Pickup and Meeting Point

Please arrive at the designated pickup point at the specified time. Late arrival is not permitted. This product cannot be cancelled, changed, transferred to another departure, or joined midway. Guests who miss the tour for personal reasons shall bear the resulting loss.

2) During the Tour

- Guests may not leave the group early or leave the tour midway. Any unused portion will be considered voluntarily forfeited and will not be refunded. Guests shall be responsible for any accident occurring after leaving the group.

- During peak travel periods or other special periods, the departure time may be brought forward or slightly delayed. The final departure time is subject to the guide’s notification.

- Transportation, sightseeing, and stopover times are subject to actual conditions on the day.
