10: 30	Yamanashi	▼ Popular photo spot-Arakurayama Sengen Park-the perfect location to enjoy the panoramic view of Mt. Fuji (about 60 minutes) The new Internet celebrity attraction is known as one of the "21 places that photographers around the world must visit before they die." This is an excellent location to enjoy the panoramic view of Mt. Fuji. Climb the 397 steps near the main shrine, and the five-story Chureito Pagoda will come into view. You can take photos of the "five-story pagoda, Mt. Fuji, and the street view at the foot of the mountain" all at once. Photographers from all over the world Tourists and tourists come here to see not only the cherry blossoms in spring, but also the fresh greenery in summer, red leaves in autumn, and snowy scenery in winter. In addition to enjoying the superb view of Mt. Fuji, you can also overlook the charming streets of Fujiyoshida City.
11: 45	Yamanashi	▼ Hikawa Clock Shop - Unlock the hidden version of the camera to take pictures of Japanese street scenes, with Mt. Fuji at the end (about 20 minutes) Escape from the hustle and bustle of the city and come to Mt. Fuji's "Ladder Town", the street leading to Mt. Fuji. The quiet street is like a ladder. At the end of the road is Mt. Fuji, infinitely close but out of reach, The popular Instagram check-in spot Hikawa Clock Shop has many tourists. You can take photos of Japanese-style street scenes. Watching Mt. Fuji merge with the street is also a different experience, and it is very photogenic! ※ If the scenic spots are unsightly due to weather or other force majeure factors, no refunds will be issued until the film is released! !
12: 30	Yamanashi	▼ Discover the clear spring ponds of Oshino Hakkai at the foot of Mt. Fuji (about 90 minutes) [Oshino Hakkai] (1 hour) The so-called "Oshino Hakkai" are actually eight clear springs formed by filtering the snow water from Mt. Fuji through the ground. Oshino Hakkai is famous for its beautiful natural environment. The sparkling water of the pool is integrated with the beautiful Mt. Fuji. It is so beautiful that it attracts countless photographers who have traveled thousands of miles to take pictures. Oshino Hakkai is a nationally designated natural monument.
14: 30	Yamanashi	▼ Lawson Convenience Store--a popular photography spot (about 30 minutes) One complimentary item per guest—ice cream, hot coffee, iced coffee, hot tea, or iced tea. The driver will purchase the items together for the group. How to take street scenes at Lawson convenience store, a celebrity in Lake Kawaguchi? Set up a tripod across the street and turn on the portrait mode, wait patiently until there are fewer people, and quickly snap a photo! ! Although taking pictures is beautiful, you must pay attention to safety when crossing the road! ※ If the scenic spots are unsightly due to weather or other force majeure factors, no refunds will be issued until the film is released! !
15: 20	Yamanashi	▼ Lake Kawaguchi Oishi Park (about 50 minutes, go to Oishi Park during non-seasonal restrictions and do not go to the Maple Leaf Corridor) Every summer, the lavender in Oishi Park on the shore of Lake Kawaguchi is in full bloom, covering the park with a purple carpet, which contrasts with the scenery of Mt. Fuji and is breathtakingly beautiful. In autumn, the broom grass (kochia) in the park will turn red and look particularly furry and cute. This is also the venue for the Kawaguchiko Herb Festival. (Lavender in June-July, crabapple and cosmos in July-September, and kochia in October) ▼ Kawaguchiko Maple Leaf Corridor (seasonal limit period 10/20-11/23, this attraction takes about 50 minutes, do not go to Oishi Park) The contrast between the snow-capped Fuji and the fiery red maple leaves is a sight you don't want to miss. This rare event once a year is waiting for your participation and visit. The shores of Lake Fujikawaguchi are colorfully decorated with red maples, and the magnificent golden autumn scenery is mesmerizing. ▼ Kawaguchiko Cherry Blossom Festival (Seasonal highlight: 03/30 – 04/14, subject to actual blooming conditions. The dates may be adjusted depending on the flower season. This attraction is added for about 20 minutes, and the Oishi Park time is changed to 40 minutes) The Fuji Kawaguchiko Cherry Blossom Festival will be held in the north shore area of Lake Kawaguchiko (next to the Lake Kawaguchiko Circular Hall). This is a famous check-in spot where Mt. Fuji, the lake and the cherry blossoms are in full bloom.
16: 20		End today's itinerary and start the return trip (the return time for the Sakura Festival trip is expected to be extended to 16:40). The return time is for reference only. You may return earlier due to smooth itinerary, good road conditions, etc. on the day.
18: 50	Tokyo	Estimated arrival at JR Tokyo Station Marunouchi South Exit, Tokyo MODE Academy, or your hotel/B&B. Tour ends upon arrival. VIPs who have a boarding and alighting package can break up the group directly at Tokyo Station or Shinjuku to end their trip. VIP guests of the hotel and B&B pick-up package should wait for the shuttle bus to arrive and arrange to return to the hotel/B&B to end the trip.

- 3) Elderly guests are required to provide a health certificate. Please complete the certificate and submit it to the booking staff before departure. An electronic copy is acceptable.

- 5) Guests who are not Chinese mainland nationals may book this product. However, language services are available only in Chinese and Japanese.

- 1) Pickup and Meeting Point
Please arrive at the designated pickup point at the specified time. Late arrival is not permitted. This product cannot be cancelled, changed, transferred to another departure, or joined midway. Guests who miss the tour for personal reasons shall bear the resulting loss.
- 2) During the Tour
 - Guests may not leave the group early or leave the tour midway. Any unused portion will be considered voluntarily forfeited and will not be refunded. Guests shall be responsible for any accident occurring after leaving the group.
 - During peak travel seasons or other special periods, the departure time may be brought forward or slightly delayed. The final departure time is subject to the guide's notification.
 - Transportation, sightseeing, and stopover times are subject to actual conditions on the day. In special circumstances, such as traffic congestion or adverse weather, the guide may reasonably adjust the order of attractions after consulting with guests, provided that no attraction is removed from the itinerary.
